Yellowstone Adventure!

Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Billings, MT. Depending on arrival time explore Pompey's Pillar National Monument and see the only remaining physical evidence of the Lewis & Clark Expedition appearing on the trail as it did 200 years ago.

Day 2: Depart for **Yellowstone Park** in the morning. We will be traveling through Red Lodge, Montana and up the **Cooke City** highway on our way to elevations just under 11,000 feet. After we have lunch in Cooke City at the "top of the world", we will then experience the **Lamar Valley**, **Tower Falls**, **Norris Geyser Basin**, and **Mammoth Hot Springs**, arriving for the night in **West Yellowstone**.

Day 3: Morning visit to **Old Faithful** and the surrounding geysers, following by a tour of **Grand Teton National Park** in the afternoon. This evening stay in historic Jackson and have time for shopping and exploring this famous western town.

Day 4: Morning stop at the National Elk Refuge – home to thousands of elk, a large Bison heard and other wildlife. Return to Yellowstone through the Tetons and visit the following stops: **Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone**, **Yellowstone Lake**, and **Firehole Canyon**. In the late afternoon we will depart through the East Entrance of the Park, pass through the **Wapiti Valley**, and arrive in **Cody, Wyoming**.

Day 5: Morning at the Buffalo Bill Cody Historical Center and Museum. Afternoon departure for Pryor, Montana where we will spend time on the **Diamond Hanging Seven Ranch** in the **Pryor Mountains** on the **Crow Indian reservation**. Afternoon optional horseback ride. Evening campfire and music.

Day 6: In the morning we will travel to **Big Horn Canyon**, one of Montana's best kept secrets. We will travel deep into the canyon on pontoon boats with massive cliffs on our sides that can go as high as 1000 feet. This deep, scenic canyon offers excellent visibility of geologic formations.

Day 7: Depart for home.

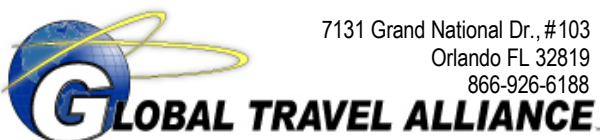
